4. Personalize the voice mail

Once you set up the voice mail on the Fritz!Box, this can be customized via the voice menu.

To do this, take one of the phones that is connected to the Fritz!Box and call the internal number for the voice mail. The default number is ****600**.

If several voice mails were set up, find their internal numbers under 'Telephony devices' in column entitled 'Internal'.

The voice menu will guide you through the settings.

4.1 Recording a personalized message

- Select the internal number for the desired voice mail (default number: **600).
- After the first prompt press 4.
- Now press 1 to create a new greeting message.
- You can now start a new recording by pressing 8 speak after the tone. Stop the recording by pressing 1.
- If you wish, you can now listen to the newly recorded message again by pressing 0.
