	Costs and general information
<b>Basic fee per month</b>	None
<b>Usage charge</b>	CHF 5.00 per calendar day
<b>Activation, Billing</b>	<p>If the option is installed, the usage charge will be billed at the time of the first billable use abroad (Region 1). The included services can then be utilized up to midnight of the same calendar day.</p> <p><i>For example: The travel day pass option is installed. The first use abroad is at 9 a.m.; the option is activated and the included services can be used until 11:59 p.m. (CET). If the option is uninstalled, then calls, SMS and mobile Internet abroad will be billed at the standard roaming rate.</i></p> <p>The usage charge is only billed if the roaming services (incoming or outgoing calls, SMS or data connection abroad) are not already free due to the mobile subscription or a previously subscribed roaming option (for more information, see "Order of precedence").</p> <p>Please note: Calendar days are always based on the Swiss time zone (CET).</p>
<b>Region 1 countries</b>	<p>The travel day pass option is valid for the following Region 1 countries:</p> <p>Austria, Andorra, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Faroe Islands, Finland, France, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Greenland, Guernsey, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Isle of Man, Italy, Jersey, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal (including Madeira, Azores), Romania, San Marino, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain (including Canary Islands, Balearic Islands), Sweden, Turkey, United Kingdom UK, United States of America (including Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico), and Vatican City.</p> <p>Overseas territories of the countries listed are excluded, particularly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– The Netherlands: excluding Bonaire, Sint Eustasius, Saba, Aruba, Curacao, Sint Maarten.</li> <li>– France: excluding French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Mayotte, Réunion, Saint-Martin, Saint-Barthélemy, Saint-Pierre and Miquelon, Wallis and Futuna, French Polynesia, New Caledonia.</li> <li>– USA: excluding American Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam.</li> <li>– United Kingdom UK: excluding Anguilla, Bermuda, British Virgin Islands, Falkland Islands, Cayman Islands, Montserrat, Pictairn, St. Helena, Ascension, Tristan da Cunha, South Georgia, Sandwich Islands, Turks and Caicos Islands</li> </ul>

<b>Calls within a country in Region 1</b>	Unlimited
<b>Calls to Switzerland from a country in Region 1</b>	Unlimited
<b>Calls from a country in Region 1 to other countries in Region 1</b>	Unlimited
<b>Incoming calls</b>	Unlimited
<b>Sending an SMS worldwide</b>	Unlimited
<b>Receiving an SMS</b>	Free of charge
<b>Sending an MMS</b>	CHF 1.00/MMS
<b>Order of precedence Calling credit volume</b>	<p>If several roaming calling/SMS volume credits are available during a stay abroad, they will be used up in the following order:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Volume from an activated travel days option</li> <li>2. Volume from the mobile subscription</li> <li>3. Volume from another activated recurring roaming option</li> <li>4. Volume from travel day pass</li> </ol>
<b>Special and short numbers</b>	Calls made from the roaming country to normal special and short numbers within the country, including value-added services, are charged at the standard rate and are not included in the roaming option.
<b>Toll-free numbers</b>	Calls made from a foreign country to toll-free numbers in the same country or another country are charged at a higher rate for special numbers and are not included in the roaming option.
<b>Satellite roaming</b>	Roaming over satellite connections, such as in airplanes and on cruise ships, is not included in the roaming option and is charged at the standard roaming rate (satellite roaming).
<b>Transfer to Sunrise mailbox</b>	If a message is received in your mailbox during a stay abroad, the costs of the incoming call to the mobile device and the return call from the mobile device to the mailbox are included in the roaming option.
<b>Call forwarding</b>	In the case of call forwarding from a roaming country in Region 1 (for example, to a landline connection in Switzerland), both the incoming call and the forwarded outgoing call are included in the roaming option.
<b>Playing back voice messages</b>	Calls made from a foreign country to the Sunrise mailbox in order to listen to voice messages are included in Region 1; otherwise, they are charged at the standard roaming rate. <a href="#">See roaming price list.</a>

	Mobile internet services included
<b>Mobile Internet Region 1</b>	100 MB per calendar day included
<b>Data speed</b>	<p>Surfing abroad is also possible with high-speed 4G (up to 100 Mbps), depending on the country and the roaming partner. See <a href="http://sunrise.ch/roaming">sunrise.ch/roaming</a> for a list of countries and roaming partners.</p> <p>Note: High-speed surfing abroad does not count against the monthly national high-speed data volume of the Freedom subscription.</p>
<b>Usage control</b>	<p>Information about current data consumption is provided as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SMS message once the included data volume has been used up</li> </ul> <p>The data consumption can also be viewed at <a href="http://cockpit.sunrise.ch">cockpit.sunrise.ch</a></p>
<b>Excess data volume</b>	<p>If the included data volume of 100 MB per calendar day has been used up and no other roaming data credit is available, data connections are blocked until midnight.</p> <p>To continue surfing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Add data volume with a travel data option</li> <li>• Deactivate the travel day pass and continue surfing at the standard roaming rate.</li> </ul> <p>The data consumption can be viewed at <a href="http://cockpit.sunrise.ch">cockpit.sunrise.ch</a>; an information SMS is sent when the credit is used up.</p>
<b>No transfer</b>	Unused data credit at the end of a calendar day is not carried forward.
<b>Billing increment Data</b>	<p>in 100 KB increments</p> <p>Every partially used unit will be billed as a full unit.</p>
<b>Order of precedence Data credit</b>	<p>If several roaming data credits are available during a stay abroad, they will be used up in the following order:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Volume from an activated travel data option</li> <li>2. Volume from an activated travel days option</li> <li>3. Volume from the mobile subscription</li> <li>4. Volume from a recurring roaming option</li> <li>5. Volume from a purchased but not yet activated travel data option</li> <li>6. Volume from a travel day pass</li> </ol>

	Usage
<b>Available for</b>	Sunrise Freedom, MTV mobile Freedom, Sunrise Mobile Unlimited (Sunrise ONE), and Business Mobile subscriptions
<b>Duration</b>	<p>The option can be installed and uninstalled at any time.</p> <p>If the option is not installed, services abroad are billed at the standard roaming rates.</p> <p>If the option is installed, then it will be automatically activated the first time calling services (incoming or outgoing call, SMS or MMS) or mobile Internet are used abroad, and the usage charge will be billed at the same time.</p>
<b>Installation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Text "daypass" to 5522</li> <li>• Call center: 0800 707 505</li> </ul>
<b>Uninstallation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• cockpit.sunrise.ch (free access worldwide)</li> <li>• Text "daypass stop" to 5522</li> <li>• Call center: 0800 707 505</li> </ul>
<b>Calendar day</b>	A calendar day extends from midnight (00:00) to one minute before midnight (11:59 p.m.) on the same day
<b>Time zone</b>	Activation, deactivation, and duration of use are always based on the Swiss time zone (CET). Pay attention to time differences.
